

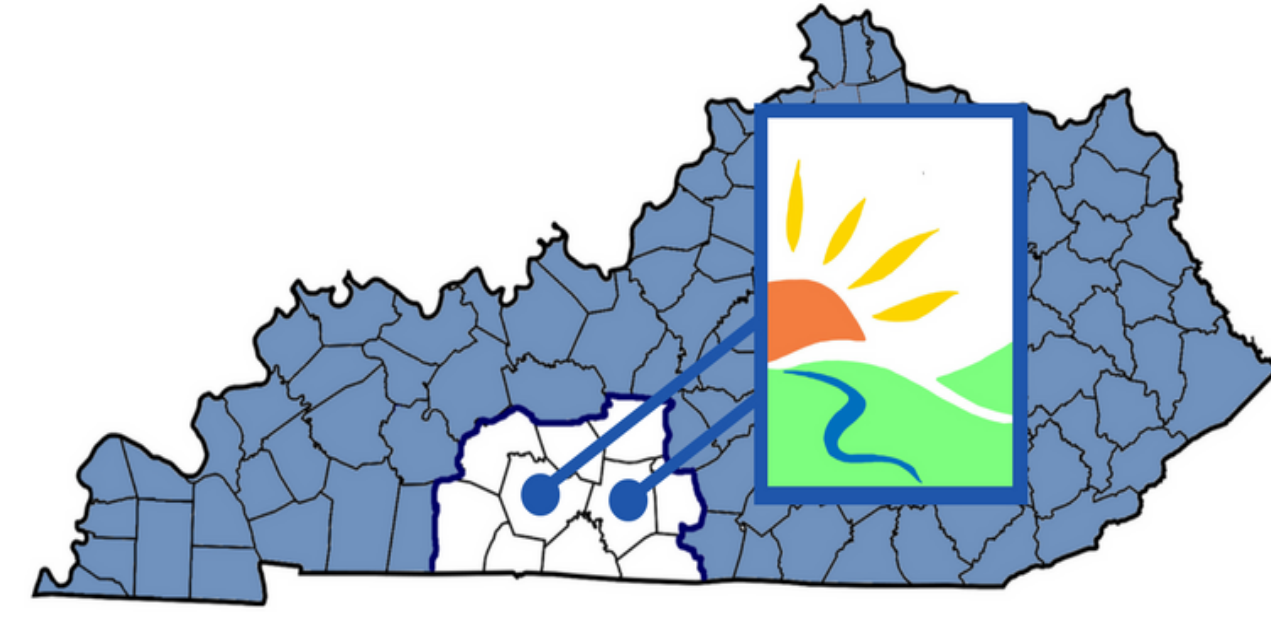

Through our program,

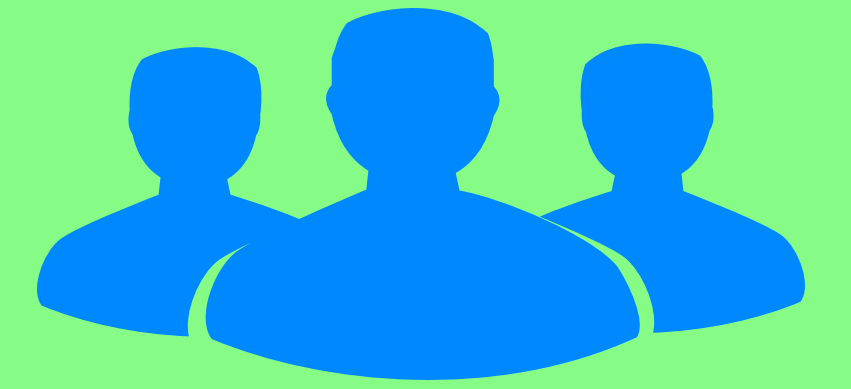
13,398

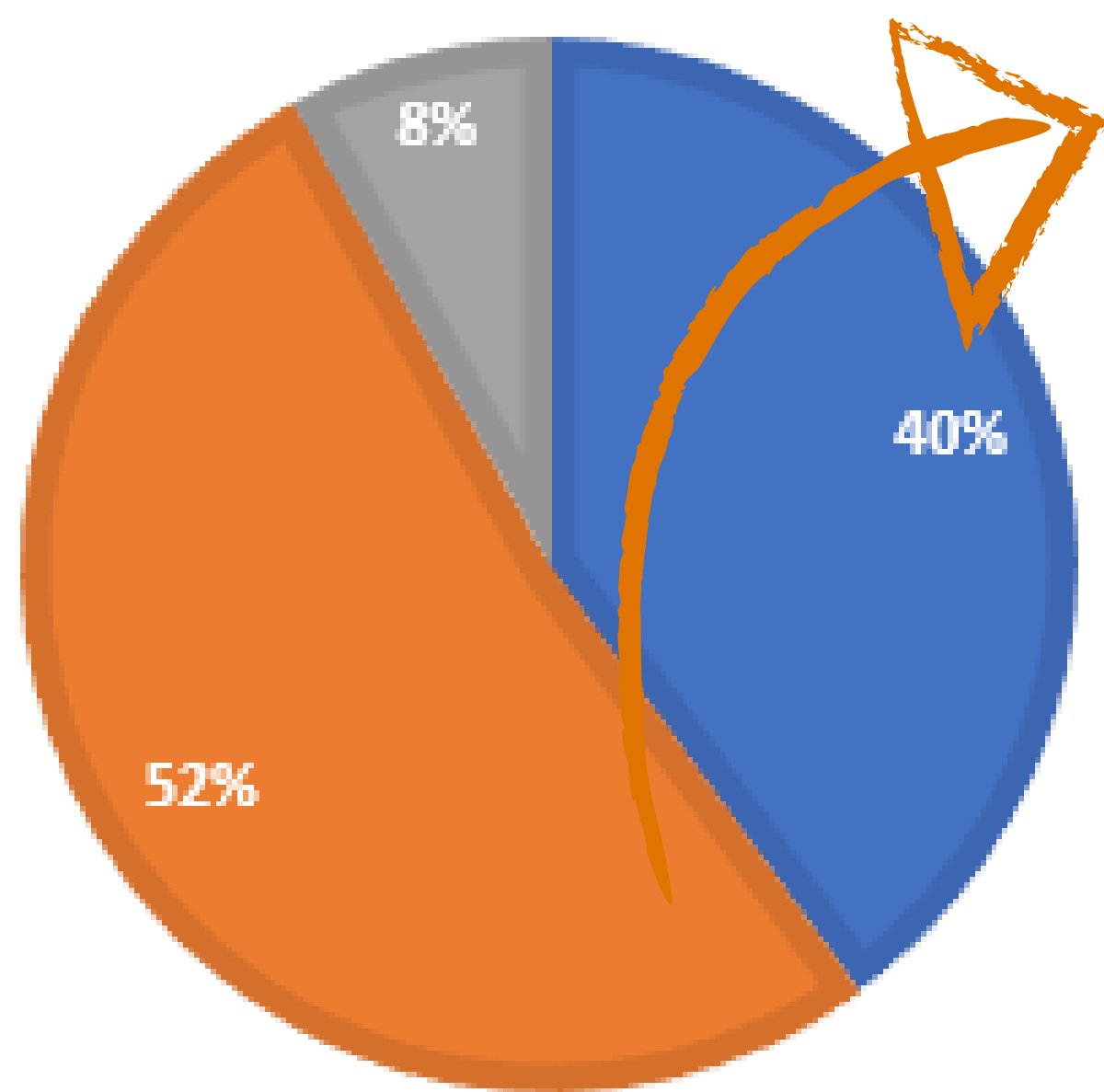


Naloxone kits dispensed in the Barren SSP from June 2019 to June 7 2022

of clients admit to sharing needles and other supplies

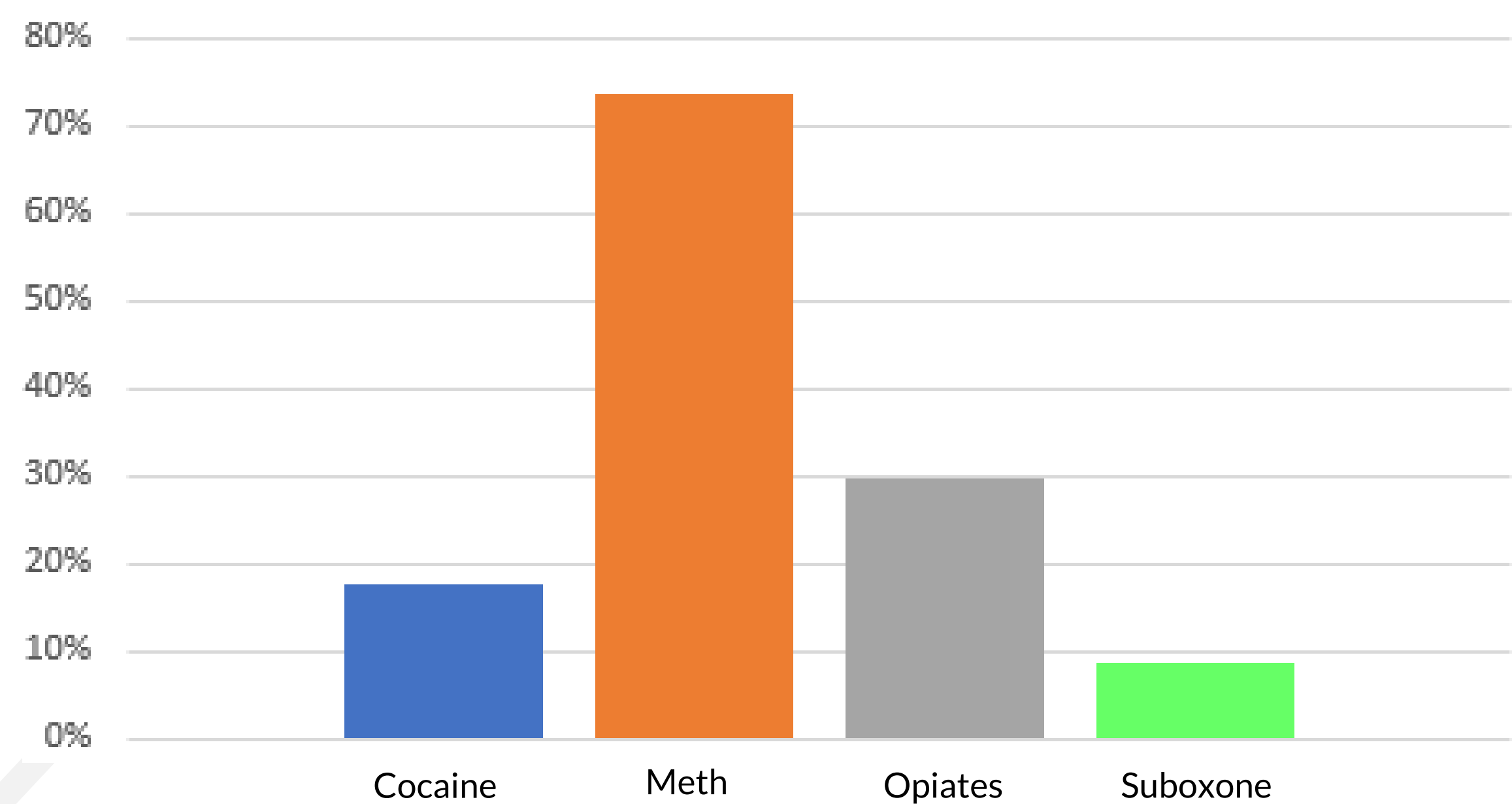
38.9%

Drug of Choice



74% of our clients say their drug of choice is methamphetamine

29.8% of our clients say their drug of choice is opiates
