


## **Barren River District Health Department** Harm Reduction & Syringe Exchange Program



- We operate 2 of the 81 syringe exchange programs servicing Kentucky:
- Warren County Health Department
- Barren County Health Department

Through our program, 343,381 dirty needles have been kept

**24%** of clients say they use drugs 1-2 times a day


drugs 3-5 times a day
