

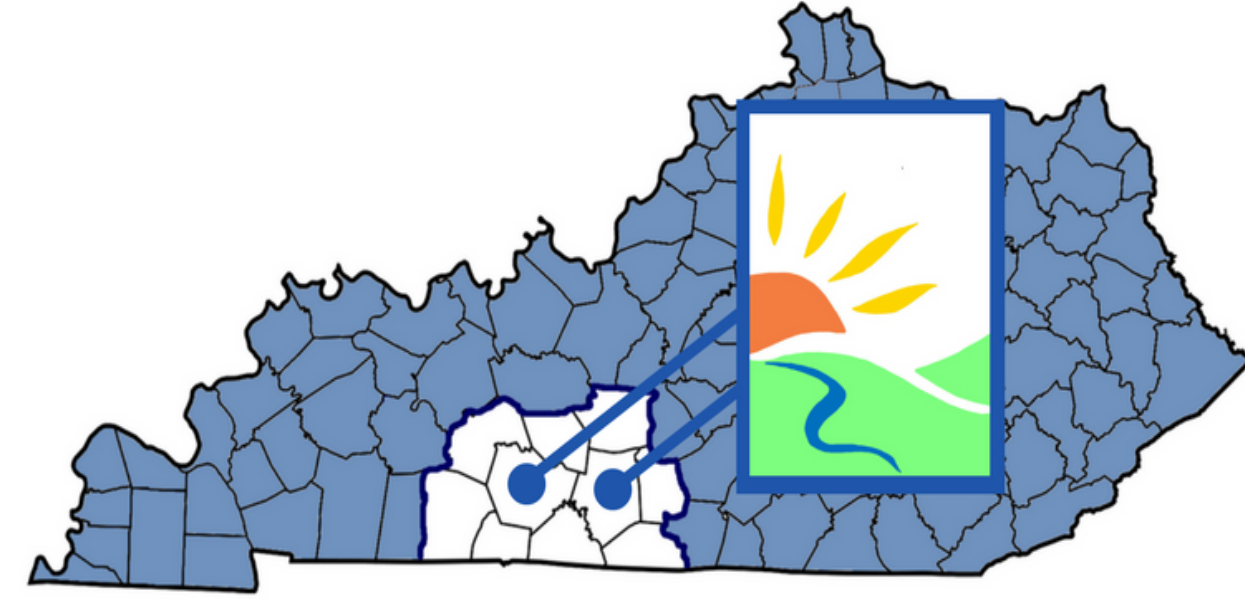

unique clients

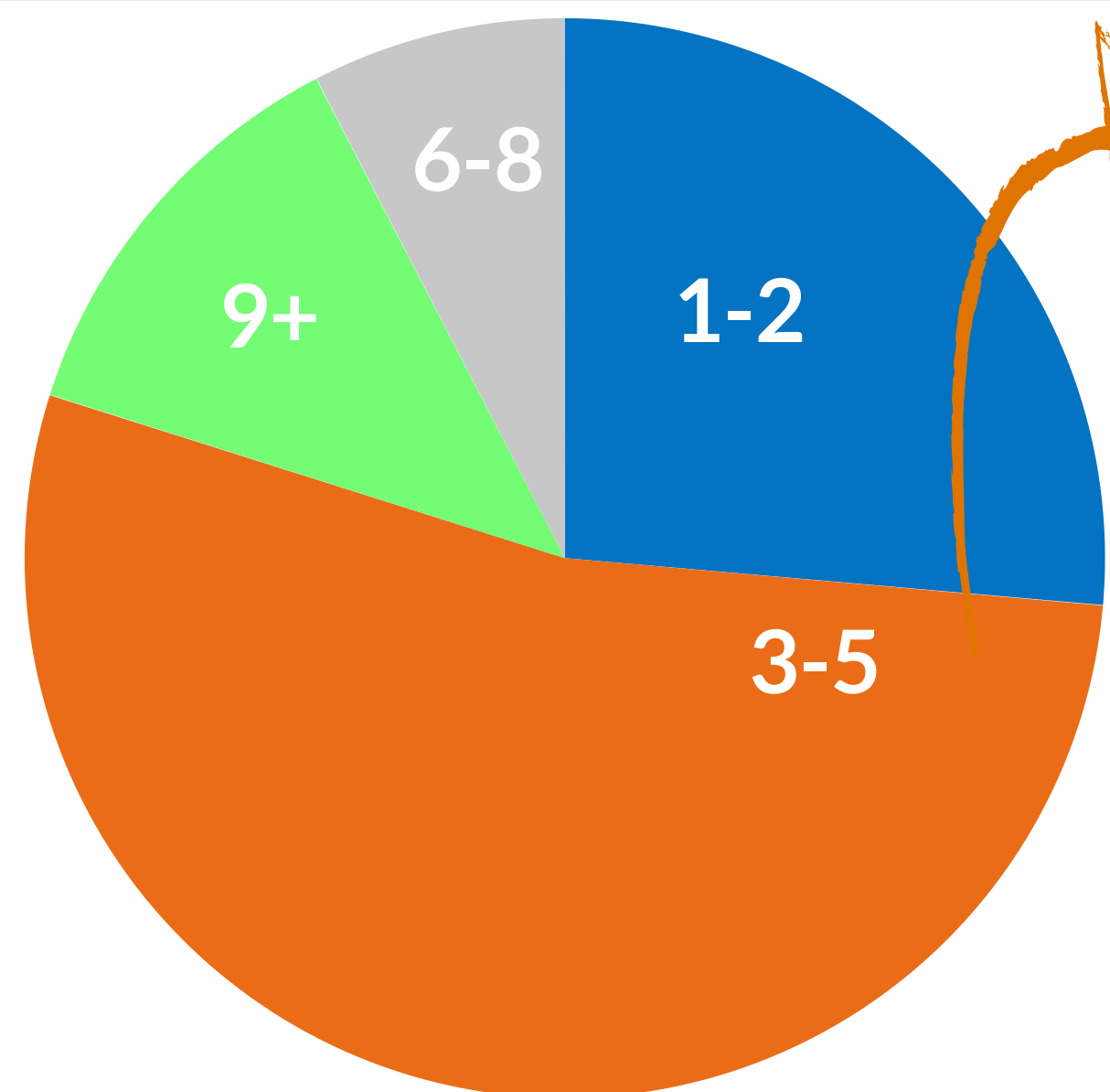

50.9% of clients say they use drugs 3-5 times a day

24% of clients say they use drugs 1-2 times a day

16.2% of clients say they use drugs 9+ times a day

35.7%

of clients have reported being positive for Hepatitis C

72.5%

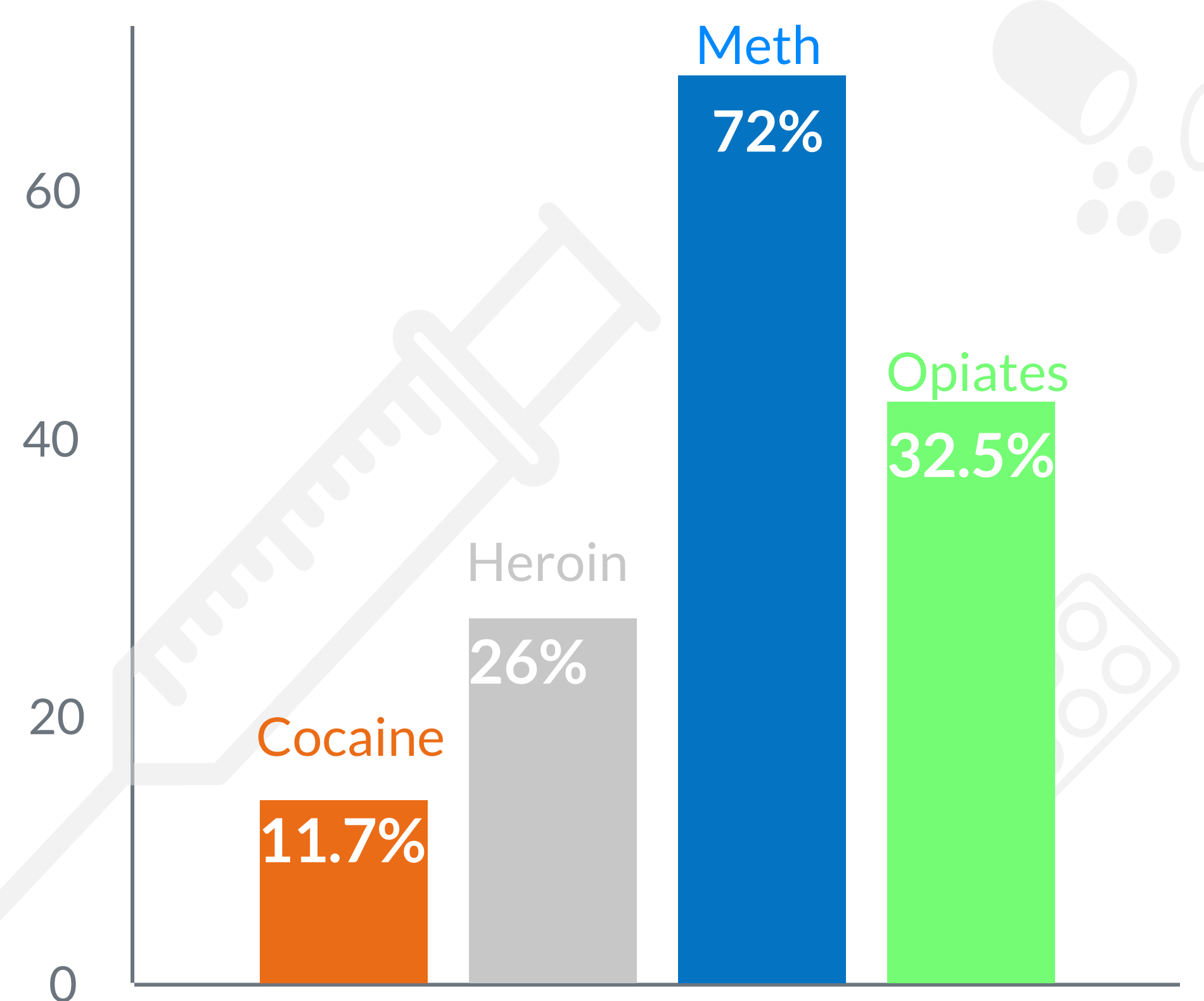
of clients admit to sharing needles and other supplies at their initial visit
